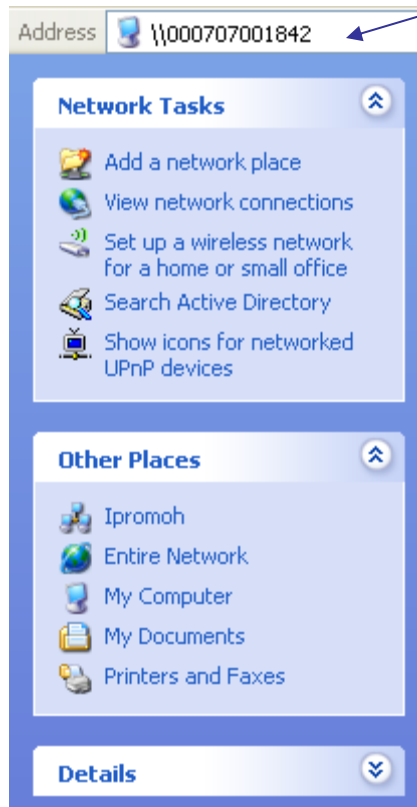

Operation Step 2:

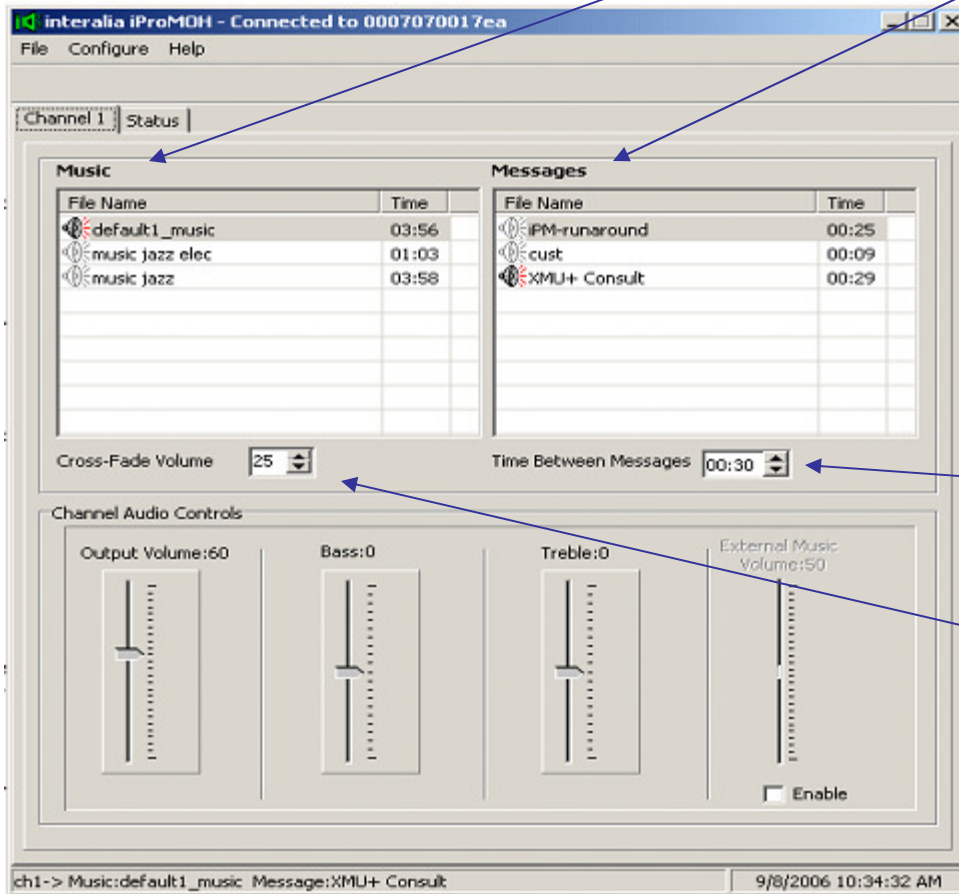
You will have separate music & message tracks

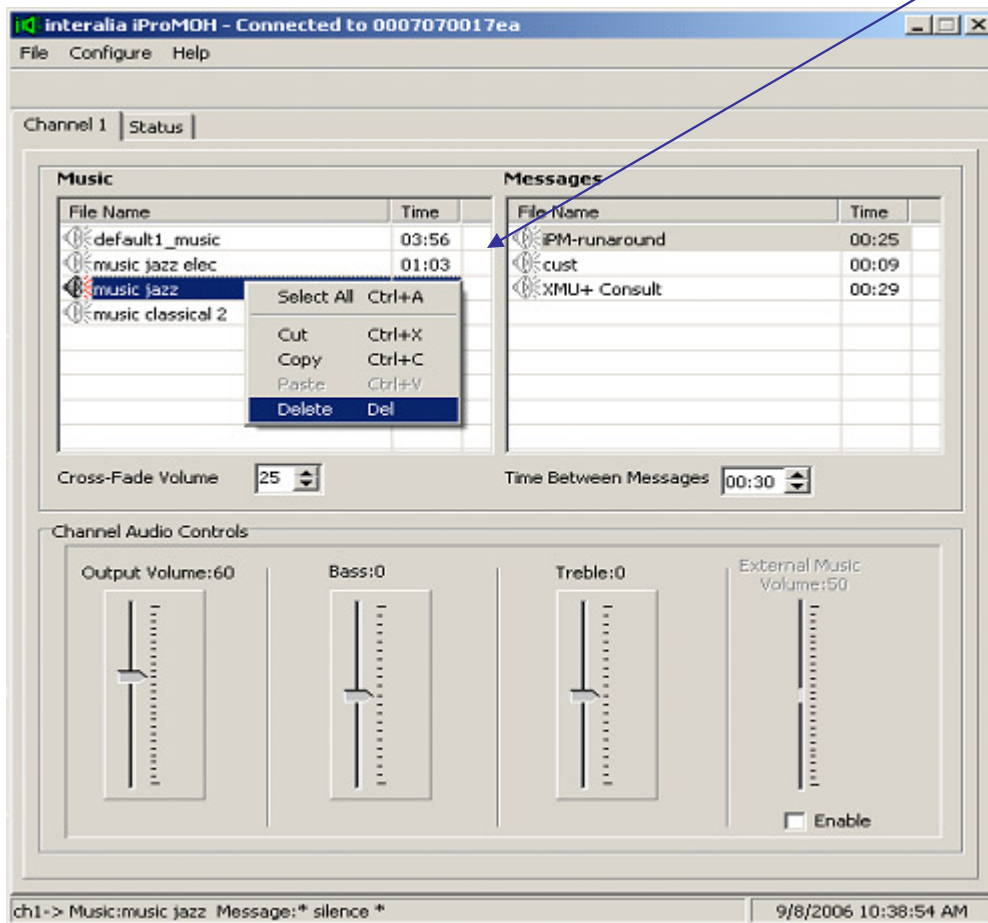

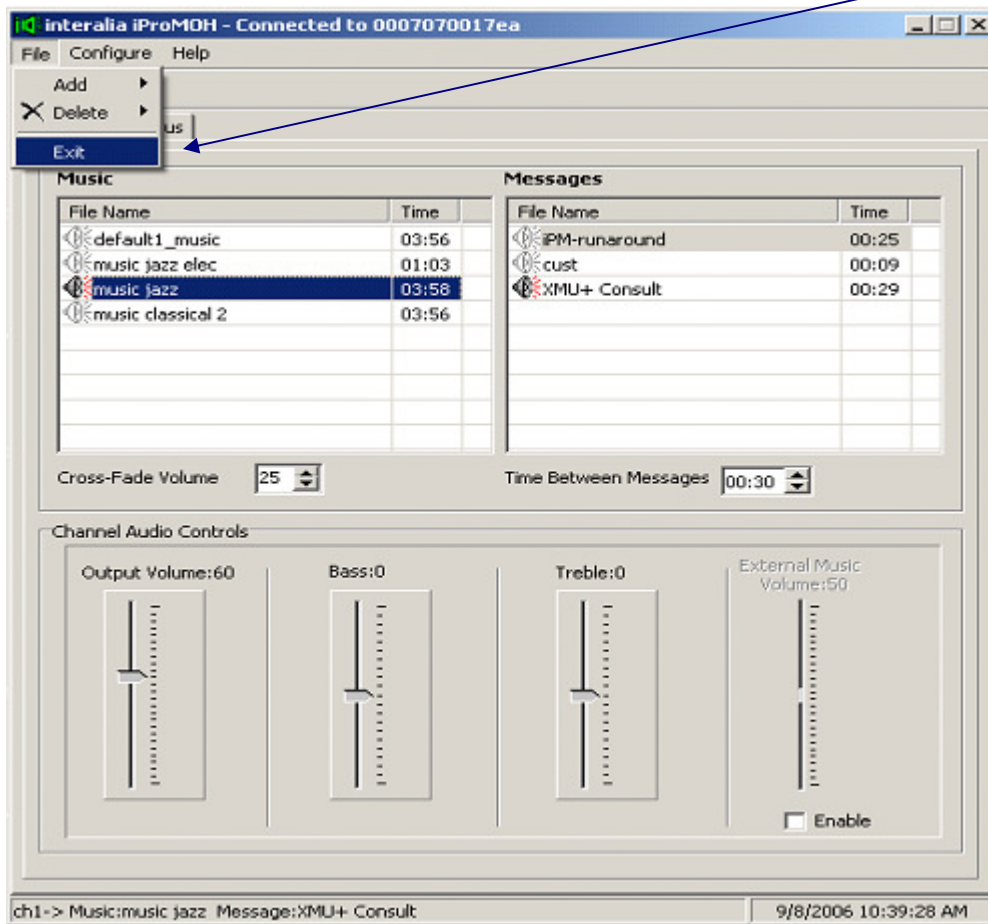
To delete a Music or Message file just highlight, right click and select Delete

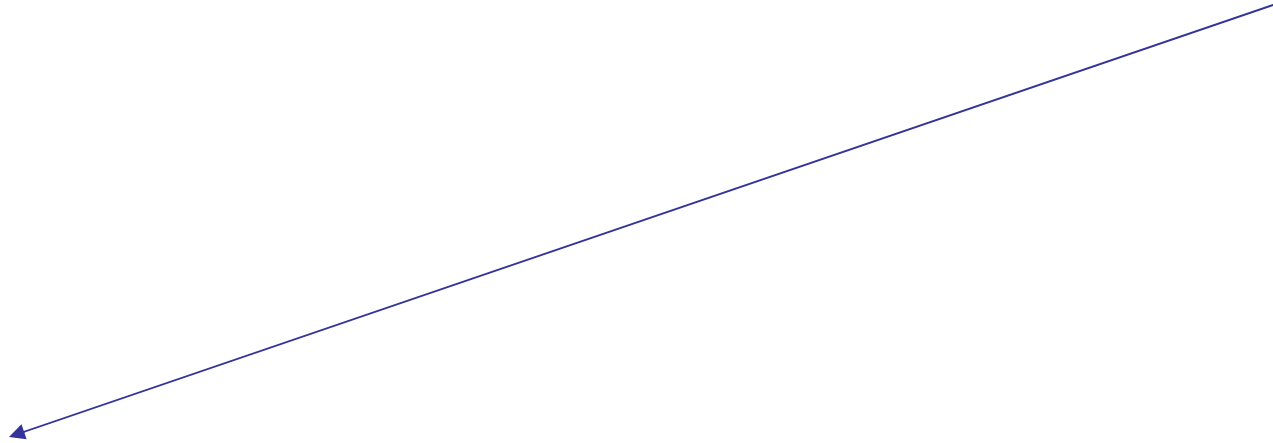
